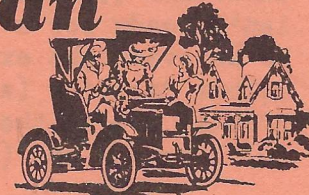
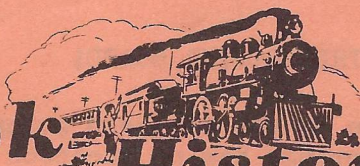

A BUS TRIP TOUR IS ON THE DRAWING BOARD!

Events Chairman Pauline Benson has been going mad (the desert flowers were uncertain ... Warner Springs has no luncheon facilities ... Temecula/Rancho isn't ready for a full-scale invasion by FHS ... Death Valley would have to be an overnight excursion (maybe later) ... so guess what? We're going to Balboa Park for (a) a tour of the San Diego Zoo (what's more historic (no greater zoo in the world) and how many years since most of us have been there?) (b) luncheon and (c) leisure time to browse at will in this beautiful park.

DATE: Wed., May 6th DEPART: 9:30 A. M. sharp, from Harrison's rear parking lot (park cars closest to library)

COST: \$17.50 per person ... includes round-trip bus fare; tickets to zoo; luncheon (including tip)

DETAILS: We will be taken on a 40 minute conducted tour of the zoo in a zoo bus.

Luncheon will be at 12:45 at the Lagoon Terrace (outside tables with umbrellas, overlooking the lovely lagoon at the zoo.)
