- 2) Subject matter must be within acceptable "family" parameters.
- 3) Contestant's mailing envelope should have "Whopper" written in lower left hand corner.
- 4) Entrants must be 21 years of age (and up) and all entries identified with contestant's name, address and phone number.
- 5) Any contestant desiring the return of his/her entry must enclose a return stamped envelope.

Judging the entries will be: Henry M. Busch (a real life judge,) and FHS Vice President; Dr. Floyd Markham and Orville Evans, FHS Directors. They will select the 10 best entries, and these finalists will be so advised by phone. These finalists will verbally present their "Whoppers" (for a maximum of 5 minutes each) at the August 6th event. Audience applause (or further refined measures, should there be close competition) will determine the grand prize winner ... who will receive a \$25 cash award from FHS, plus be proclaimed in the media as "The Biggest Liar in the Area."
